

Advent Week 4 Study Questions

Read Romans 10:13-15

What point is Paul trying to make?

Although we are in a heavily saturated “Christian” area, do you we give people an adequate opportunity to hear the Good News? Why or why not?

Read Matthew 5:14

What is the foundational truth?

In what way is Jesus the light of the world and in what way are we the light of the world?

Read Matthew 5:15

How do we compare to a city on a hill? What point is Jesus trying to make with this metaphor?

Read Philippians 2:14-16

How does it describe one way we can shine as lights? What are other ways?

Read Matthew 5:15

Jesus makes the point that lighting a light and proceeding to hide it is absurd. How does that relate to us being the light of the world?

Read Matthew 5:16

What is the application to Jesus’ message?

How does being a “light” differ from Matthew 6:1 where Jesus warns people not to practice their righteousness before others?

You are a light. That’s non-negotiable. Who has God put you in a position to be a light to? How can you practice putting your light on a stand as opposed to hiding it?
